Please read the following procedures carefully.

U.S. Figure Skating has increased the membership fee by \$5 for the coming year. Our membership dues have been adjusted to reflect this increase. The renewal fees are as follows:

Members who are seeking to change to collegiate status need to include a letter of acceptance from the appropriate college.

Junior Club membership will renew at the end of August for those skaters who are not moving up at this time.
